

Connect Your People

As you move from office to home, have you considered your primary way to stay in contact with your people? Are you covered? Handsets play a key part of a homeworker's equipment. Many businesses right now may not have enough mobile devices to provide each employee and limiting contact over email won't always be enough to stay in touch with your teams or keep them as motivated and engaged as a voice or video call would.

Data Access

With the use of a mobile handset, creating a 'mobile hotspot' or 'tethering' is an easy way to gain internet access. Although you will require enough data allowance to do so from your mobile, it simply allows you to connect any device to the hotspot and share the internet connection. With this, it also removes the need for an additional USB dongle, so it's one less device you need to manage. You can be sure your dedicated data network won't be disturbed. Data Connectivity

Mobile broadband is increasingly being used by homeworkers as they require access to cloud-based applications such as google, Microsoft Teams and Office 365. Often, you can be at the mercy of poor connecting home-broadband which experiences peaks and troughs of performing bandwidth and struggling download and upload speeds; mobile broadband gives you the solution.

What are the advantages of Mobile Broadband?

- You're not restricted to working in one place – you can pick up 3G, 4G and now 5G signal in most locations
- It allows you to work more flexibly as you would no longer be restricted to working in areas with WIFI connections only
- Mobile broadband is secure as all data is encrypted, more so than a WIFI connection
- The ability to work anywhere means that you can save costs by minimising office space requirements
- You won't need a landline or cable to access the internet, saving you on costly expenses
- You can use mobile broadband to use VoIP technology to call people – rather than paying for minutes to international or costly numbers.

Did You Know?

A recent Ofcom report suggested 80% of homes and businesses in the UK have good indoor 4G coverage, with 5G now available in over 70 towns and cities across the UK.



Upgrading your Data Allowance

Exceeding the use of the current data allowance can easily be done when sharing the handset internet connection with a laptop or tablet which is in use all day.

Why not upgrade your current data allowance for a plan that ensures you and your team are covered, when you need to get connected online?

Tips for Managing Mobile Data Usage

Consider the usage of each employee.

This may vary across your team depending on what they require the device for. Some may use mobiles minimally, whilst others will consume more data.

Do you have a shared data allowance?

You might allow a monthly data usage of 3GB per user, but there will be many users only using 1GB whilst others need 5GB. Without a shared data allowance, you'll end up overspending for some users whilst others (unintentionally) allow data to go to waste. This can be far more cost effective (share data pools) than each individual plan.

Can you track current levels of data spend during the month? Or are you receiving extra charges for exceeding your data limits?



Preparing for the future

Over the last decade our mobile data usage has showed no signs of slowing. With the introduction of 5G, it will provide users with faster connection speeds and greater convenience but will also radically increase the data consumption.
